PICK ONE OF EACH: APPETIZER, MAIN COURSE, AND DESSERT

APPETIZERS

Poster: Make a poster with a map showing 20 labeled physical features (mountains, lakes, rivers, etc.) of Colorado.

Write: 1 page- compare/contrast the geography of Colorado with the geography of another state. Create: Any visual representation of geologic attributes of Colorado- include different rocks/minerals and how they have changed over time.

MAIN COURSE

Video: Interview someone from a Native American tribe in Colorado. Discuss how geography impacts their lives (10 minutes with editing, titles, and at least five questions).

Create: Make an informative brochure with text and pictures showing off the geography of Colorado to attract visitors.

Write: 3 pages- argue why human impact is good or bad for Colorado geography.

DESSERT

Postcards: Make two postcards highlighting Colorado's geography with a picture on one side and a message on the other side.

Timeline: Show 10 geographic changes of Colorado on a timeline, either natural or created by humans.

Write: 1 page- write about the history of Pikes Peak.
